Janet Moyer Landscaping Recommends Top Ten “Must See” Garden Destinations in San Francisco

Janet Moyer, the company’s founder and president, has selected the following ten “must see” garden destinations that are her personal favorites and will please city residents and tourists alike:

1. Golden Gate Park – Built in the 1870s over sand dunes reaching to the heart of San Francisco, this urban park offers over 1,000 acres of beautifully manicured and natural gardens.
2. San Francisco Botanical Garden – Located in Golden Gate Park, it houses diverse plant collections and hosts educational programs dedicated to conservation.
3. Conservatory of Flowers – A unique living museum that opened its doors in 1879 displays rare and exotic plants and tropical flowers.
4. Japanese Tea Garden – The oldest public Japanese garden in the United States features traditional monuments, bridges and native Japanese plants and ponds.
5. San Francisco Zoo – Located along the Great Highway at the Pacific Ocean, the SF Zoo is not just about animals. The planting provides a woodland feel that complements the setting.
6. Pier 39 – Known for shopping and dining, this popular attraction is surrounded by lush planting and is home to 39,000 tulips during “Tulipmania” each spring.
7. Crissy Field – This former early twentieth century military airfield has been converted into a 130-acre multi-use open space with a coastal marsh that is home to more than 100,000 native plants and 110 species.
8. California Academy of Sciences – The Living Roof at the Academy has 1.7 million native plants chosen to flourish in Golden Gate Park.

9. Yerba Buena Gardens – Near downtown San Francisco lays a five-and-a-half acre public meadow with trees, flowers and a waterfall surrounded by museums, galleries and cafes.

10. Lands End – Meandering paths along ocean-side cliffs are shadowed by Cypress trees and provide access to pocket beaches in this gem of the San Francisco Presidio.

7. Use newspaper and/or cardboard as a weed block for large areas. Place it on unplanted areas, moisten and cover with shredded redwood.

8. Put coffee grounds around acid loving plants like Rhododendrons, Hydrangeas, Camellias, Fuchsias and Azaleas. The grounds smell good when you're working in the garden and these plants love them.

9. Hang your clothes line east to west for best exposure. Have an extra pole with two screws in the end to support the middle of the line when heavy with wet cloths. The clothes will last longer, smell fresher and will be solar sterilized at the same time.

10. Inside: put a plastic bag loosely over fresh cut basil: set in a vase in the shade with water, making sure no leaves are under water. –basil will last 2 weeks and may even start to root for replanting.
